LEARNING FROM HOME

ABC ME Learning for Primary School Students

Primary school students now have access to interactive learning resources to support their remote and flexible learning thanks to a partnership between the Victorian Government and the ABC. Minister for Education James Merlino announced this week that the first set of fifteen learning activities connected to educational programs are screening on ABC ME (20th—24th April) and have been added to the Victorian Government's new Learning from Home website:

The activities for English, Mathematics, Science and Geography, have been designed for primary school students and are aligned to the Victorian Curriculum. Teachers will be able to use these resources to assist in delivering remote learning as well.

Students will be able to watch programs on TV via ABC ME or online via ABC iview, and then complete learning activities linked to the programs. The activities are engaging and fun so please access these if you need something extra for your children at home.

Teacher Parent Contact - No Caller ID

Teachers have been ringing parents to check in and say 'hi' to the students. The teachers have their phone setting on "No Caller ID" so if you don't normally answer those calls could you make the exception during this time as some parents have not answered their phone. It is important that teachers make these calls to connect with the students, answer any questions, offer support and motivate the students.

We have volunteers only at school to look after the children. At school it is the same as remote learning. There are no formal classes occurring as all classroom teachers are teaching from home.





Year 3 - Year 6






