CSEF FUNDING – Important Notice!

The Department of Education & Training has an annual payment which replaces the Education Maintenance Allowance. This is known as Camps, Sports & Excursions Fund (CSEF). *CSEF will be provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school excursions, camps and sporting activities to the value of \$125.00 per student.*



If you hold a means tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent you may be eligible for CSEF. Full annual payments are paid directly to the school from March 2021. This payment can be used to pay for your child's excursion levy, swimming or camp. Please speak with our office staff if you have any queries regarding your payments. Please complete an application form online, or alternatively collect one from the school office. Please return applications by Friday 25th June – end of Term 2.

WHATS HAPPENING IN VISUAL ARTS?

Aboriginal Storytelling:

Supporting their Term 1/2 inquiry units, Year 2 students have been exploring 'How Indigenous Australians make connections to their history and the land through storytelling'.

With great excitement, students welcomed Jack George. Jack shared his 'story', growing up in an indigenous family here in Melbourne. He proudly shared about his Aboriginal culture and how his family had shared stories about his culture while he was growing up and continue to do so. Jack shared with us how we can learn more about Aboriginal culture through stories told through art, music and dance. He shared instruments, boomerangs, Aboriginal football, dance and we even learned to throw a return boomerang!

Inspired by Jack's visit we created 'stories' using symbols used in indigenous art, to paint our own return boomerangs. We read the Aboriginal Dreamtime story 'Scaly- tailed Possum and Echidna' and are now making our soft toy echidnas!

We learnt:

- Indigenous Australian cultures are at least 50,000 years old.
- There is not one single Indigenous culture! Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people had more than 700 languages; each tribe with their own cultures when the first colonists arrived here in Australia.
- We live on Bunurong land. Jack's family come from the Wurundjeri and Yorta Yorta tribes.
- A digeridoo is really called a 'yidiki'.
- Jack played the digeridoo for us. It was given to him by his uncle, a much respected Indigenous elder Murrindindi (who you can meet if you visit Healesville Sanctuary).
- Indigenous football is made from possum skin and is called a 'mungrook'.
- The return boomerang was created in Victoria. They were used to hunt birds and small creatures.
