#### Teaching and Learning Program

Due to the staggered return to school, year levels will have a combination of on-site and remote learning for 3 weeks. This will impact on the number of small group sessions that will be run throughout the week. Teachers may change the frequency and focus of these sessions to allow them to carry out some assessment tasks. There will also be some changes to the remote specialist program as students will be accessing some of these sessions on-site.

It was evident that we have some skilled hockey and tennis players at AGPS. It was also wonderful to see students join us once again for our live PE workout session last Thursday.

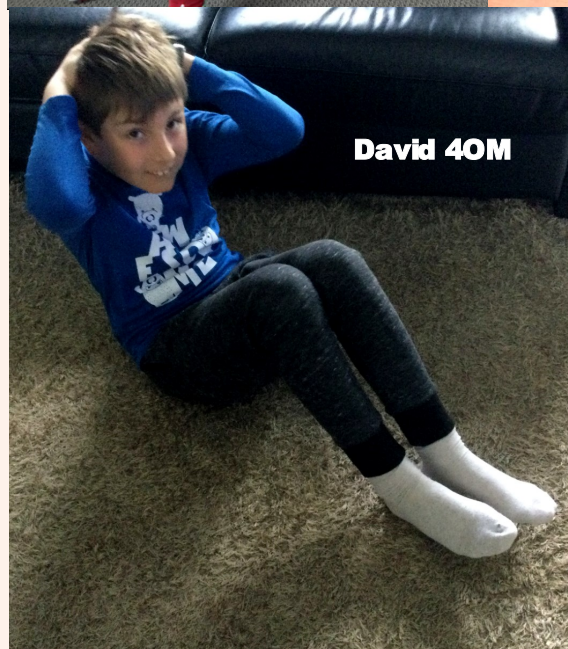
